⇒ Select * from bca where (name = "Ram" and village = "Naubatpura") OR (name = "Shyam" and village = "Piplawa");

Q:- Display records of all students who got second class.

⇒ Select * from bca where per ≥ 45 and per < 60 ;

OR

Select * from bca where per between 44.99 and 60.00;

Q:- Display records of students whose roll from 5 to 10 and 15 to 20.

⇒ Select * from bca where (roll between 4 and 11) OR (roll 14 and 21);

OR

Select * from bca where (roll ≥ 5 and roll ≤ 10) OR (roll ≥ 10 and roll ≤ 20);

* Select from where like statements :-

The like operators of SQL is used to match a pattern with the helps of character '%'. The character '%' matches 0 or more character and

displays those records matching with given character or string.

For Ex:-

Q:- Display all records ~~is~~ start with character A.

⇒ Select * from bca where name like 'A' % ;

Q:- Display all records which end with character A.

⇒ Select * from bca where name like '% A' ;
