## LIFE CYCLE OF AN APPLET

An applet is a special kind of Java program that is designed to be transmitted over the Internet and automatically executed by a Java-compatible web browser. Applets are intended to be small programs and can be downloaded. They are typically used to display data provided by the server, handle user input, or provide simple functions, such as a loan calculator, that execute locally, rather than on the server.

An Applet is a subclass of java.applet.Applet package. It doesn't consist of a main method unlike a Java application

.Different states that an applet experiences between its object creation and object removal is known as Applet Life Cycle. There are 5 states represented by 5 methods.
