The *“Code Window”* has two parts—

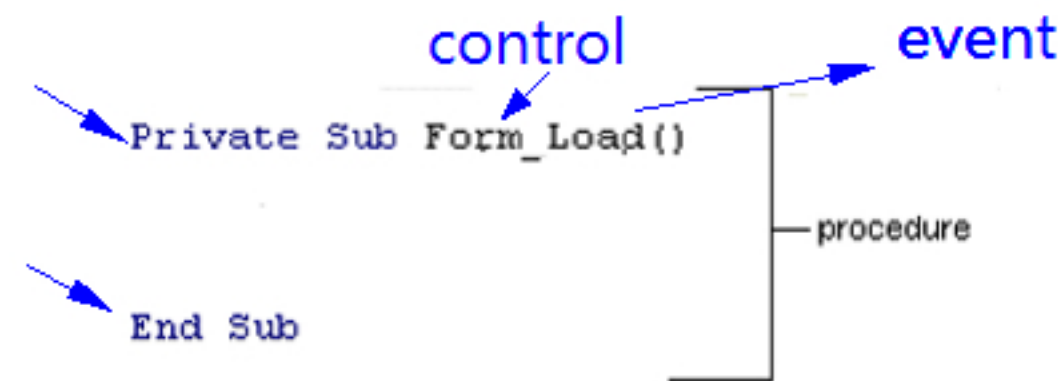
The *“left part”* shows the listing of all the controls placed over the form. And, the *“right part”* shows the listing of all the events of the selected controls.

Since, each control has several events, so we can program in different events independently.

Visual Basic automatically provides a *“procedure”* for each event separately.

A *“procedure”* is a sub program, which consists with control name & its event name. It performs a special task after performing that action. It means, any procedure is called automatically whenever we perform that action.

Here, the *“Sub”* keyword indicates that it is a Procedure.
